## A NOTE FROM THE TEACHERS

### **CLASSROOM 1**

### Goodbye February! Welcome March!

Our children had such a great moth of learning. We will continue reviewing letters, numbers and shapes of the week. We will continue our study of "Building". Our Block interest area will be set up as a construction site. Some of the fun learning activities our children will be doing include building with colorful paper shapes that will include lots of squares and rectangles and arches. They will build structures using wood scraps from the lumber store that will be safe. They will be building houses, bridges, overpasses, roads, tunnels, sky scrapers and apartments. The children will also use a variety of building tools. We will discuss that building a house or other structure requires a number of people to complete the job. Children will draw plans and designs. We will have a discussion of the duties of a concrete layer, a plumber, electrician, carpenter and painter. Children will use golf tees to hammer, sand paper of different grades for sanding and participate in a screwing activity will include soap, and wood pieces. We will continue to sing songs and read stories about building and match paint samples for color recognition. Children will use real tape measures and rulers to measure the length of boards and the sizes of their houses.

The month of March is also Dr. Seuss's Birthday. Materials will be placed around the classroom so that our children can create fun activities about Dr. Seuss. We will also introduce our children to the many books that were written by Dr. Seuss.

# HOME LEARNING / FAMILY ENGAGEMENT

"Picture This"

With this activity the primary objectives will be engaging in conversations and using social rules of language with your child.

- 1. Your child will learn language when they are allowed to lead conversations about a topic that interest them.
- 2. Take 2-3 pictures that your child might find interesting.
- 3. Invite your child to choose a picture from the collection and talk about it with you.
- 4. Encourage your child to lead the conversation, facilitating the discussion by providing prompts and asking your child open-ending questions. Such as, "Can you tell me about...? I wonder why....
- 5. Help your child put their thoughts into words by listening and restating the content of their message
