

HOME LEARNING / FAMILY ENGAGEMENT

"Planting Together"

Create a window garden with your child and talk with your child about how you will be working together to make the window garden grow. With this activity your child will gain experience in cooperating and taking responsibility.

What to do: Choose a sunny wind sill to grow a family garden together, if possible, you may create your garden outside.

- Make a list of needed items with your child and other members of the family. And together collect a few things such as seeds, potting soil, water, paper or plastic cups. Etc.
- Begin by putting soil in each cup. Give your child as many opportunities to help as possible.
- Ask your child to put seeds in the cups. Choose seeds that sprout and grow quickly, such as green peas or any kind of bean.
- Explain to your child that the plant needs time to grown. Talk about how each plant needs soil, light and water.
- Place a watering schedule near the window. Each person can take turns watering. Let your child check off their name on the schedule after their turn.
- Talk about how each plant is growing taller.
 Encourage your child to draw pictures of plants to document the growth.
